



Rogaining Queensland SEQ Rogainer of the Year Series Points System 2018

Preamble

Following the outstanding success of the SEQ Rogainer of the Year Series in 2017, it's back again for 2018. Based on the experience in the first year there have been two minor adjustments to the system for 2018:

- A. The normalisation of the scores was found to be an unnecessary complication with the overall placings based on the raw scores being near identical to those from the normalised scores. Thus the normalisation process has been dropped making the system easier to manage and easier to understand.
- B. The maximum number of scoring hours has been increased from 50 to 60 giving those better suited to the longer events improved opportunity and encouraging more participation.

System

The following events are included in the Rogaining Queensland SEQ Calendar for 2018:

1. These events will form the 2018 Rogaining Queensland SEQ Rogainer of the Year series and competitors in all these events will receive points based on their placing in the event.
2. Points are awarded to individuals not teams. Each member of a team in a particular event receives the same number of points as the other members of the team.
3. Competitors in the winning team of any event shall receive a score of 100 points times the nominal duration of the event in hours (i.e. the winners of a 24-hour event will receive a score of 2,400 points for that event).
4. All other competitors in that event shall receive a score based on their percentage of the winning score rounded to the nearest whole number. Thus if a team in 24-hour event get exactly 50% of the winning score they will receive a score of 1,200 points for that event.
5. Where a shorter duration event is conducted concurrently, points will be awarded for that shorter event as a separate event. Thus the winners of the MOJO Raid 6-Hr for example will receive a score of 600 points.
6. A competitor's points from their best 60 hours shall be their final points score for the year.
7. For each event a record will be kept of the following for each competitor:
 - a. Event duration
 - b. Points scored
 - c. Points per hour – To simplify identifying the competitor's best 60 hours
8. As it is unlikely that most competitors will have their best 60 hours in events that exactly total 60 hours the points for one event will be pro-rated as necessary to get the required best 60 hours score.
9. Any rogainer who is prevented from competing in an event because of volunteer tasks they undertook for that event will be eligible for series points with a score of the maximum duration of the event they volunteered for times the points per hour for their best competition event during the series. The maximum number of scoring volunteer hours shall not exceed 24 in the series.
