I WISH I'D KNOWN...

Hints/learnings/feedback/ideas from previous Prep parents:

- It takes a long time (for parents and kids) to adjust to the new routine, but you will get there! School days are surprisingly short.
- 'Parade' and 'Assembly' are the same thing. Try to go along it really helps you understand the school and key people (Wednesday 2.30pm).
- Engage with the P&C Facebook page it's the BEST source of information.
- There are 'Student Free Days' or 'Staff Professional Development Days' (kids don't go to school but Vacation Care is available). Most are attached to the end of school holidays but there is one in the middle of Term 4.
- Try to get to Parent Hub for a cuppa currently Tuesday mornings such an easy way to connect!
- If you can, volunteer in the classroom it's the best way to find out who all the kids are and what happens day-to-day in class.
- Information is now mainly electronic, so make sure both the School and P&C have an email address that you check daily. Sometimes notes will come home with your child, so check your child's bag regularly.
- Sneakers (any colour) and socks are fine! Velcro shoes are ideal until your child can tie their own laces.
- Your child will be in one of the house/sports teams and you will need a red, green or yellow t-shirt for sports days.
 Don't buy one until you find out which team you are in.
- 2nd-hand clothes at our uniform shop are only \$2 and there's usually a great range – wait until winter before buying jumpers/jackets and check here first!
