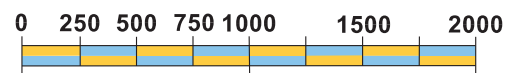




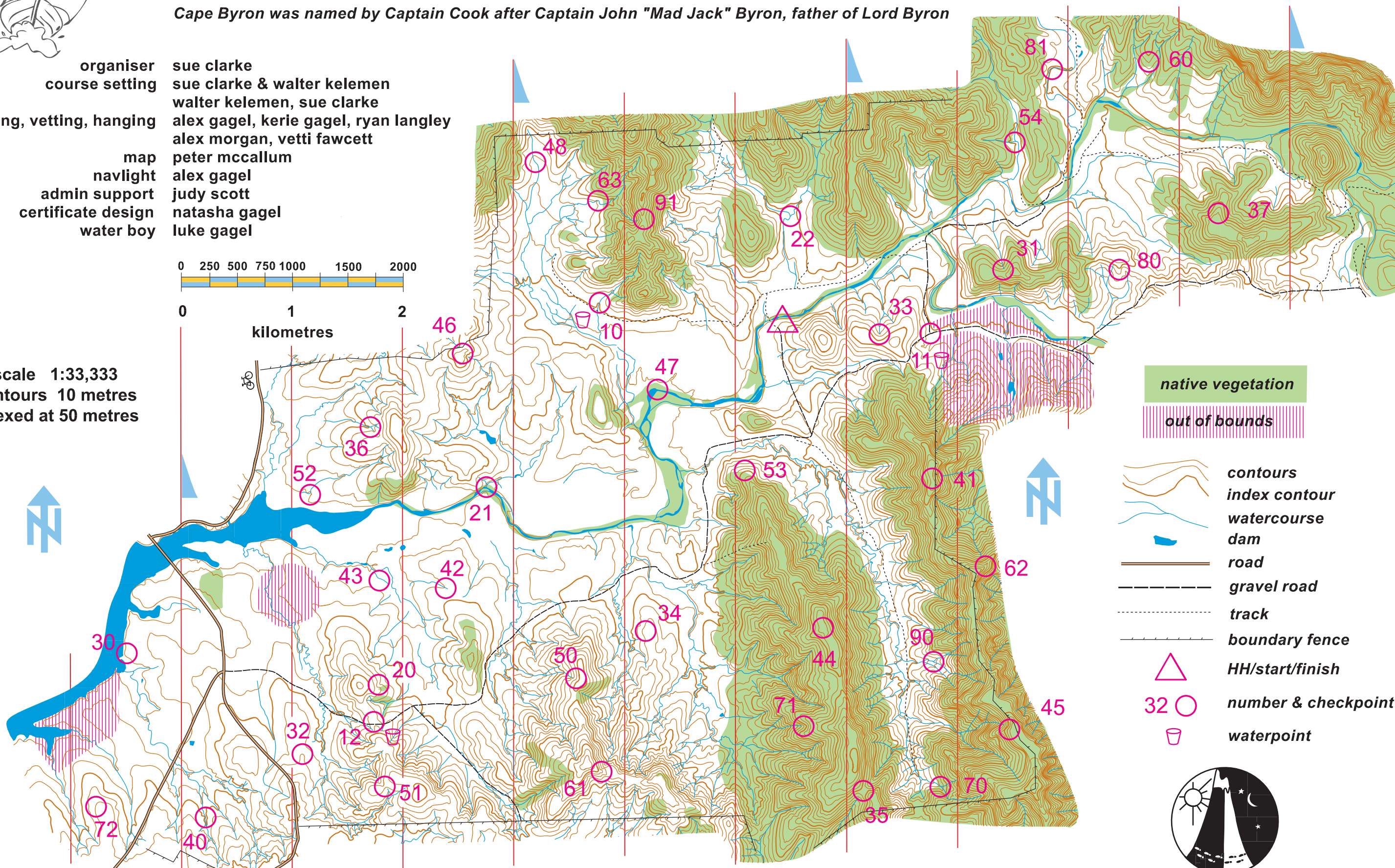
Navigate like Byron 8hour Rogaine
